Out of the 24 children in receipt of EYPP 19 were below the level expected for their age, 15 of these have SEND and ten have been referred for speech and language therapy.   |

In addition, these children have benefitted from a weekly, interactive talk and play session as well as participating in outings to Kew Gardens and the Hyde Park Learning Centre . All EYPP children have made progress from their starting points. On entry 16% of children in receipt of EYPP were at the level expected for communication and language compared to 41% of children not in receipt of EYPP. At the end of the Year the percentage of children at the expected level for communication and language had risen to 40% of EYPP children and 49% for Non EYPP; this is an increase of 24% for children in receipt of EYPP compared to 9% for Non EYPP. |
