

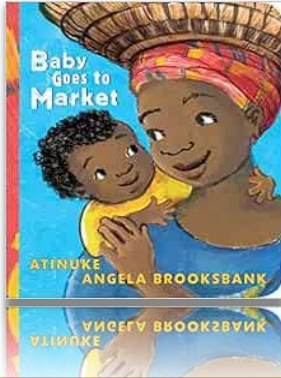


Holmewood Nursery Curriculum Newsletter 3

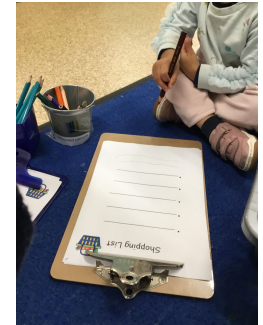
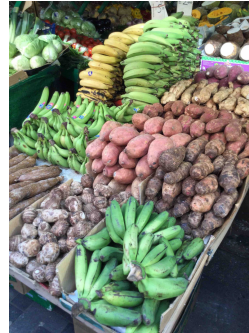


Key Vocabulary
